

Sheltered Housing

Sheltered or very sheltered houses are a group of flats or houses with a warden service. A warden is a person who helps residents and checks they are well.

Sheltered housing is for people who have a health problem or support need, and residents are usually more than 60 years old.

There is often a shared lounge where residents can enjoy activities such as classes and social events.

Sometimes there is a shared laundry room and a guest room where visitors can stay.

Very sheltered housing is for those who need a 24 hour warden service. Meals are provided.
